### **Activity**

Pupils in years 3-6 in class, small teams or individually to create a poster to promote what's important for them for online safety. This is an opportunity for children to showcase their learning at school, extending that learning to home.

### **To enter**

Visit **[www.gobubble.school](http://www.gobubble.school)**, register your school and download the free Go Bubble app from Google Play or Apple App Store.

### **Competition**

The poster should be bright, colourful and follow one of two themes:

1. I feel safe online because...
2. I can keep my friends safe by...

Make sure the poster clearly identifies the year group entry. When the poster has been created, using the Go Bubble app, take a photo and post it to the Go Bubble **Pupil Voice Week Group**.

All posters submitted by 1100 30 Sept will be entered into a competition. The winning designs for each year group (year 3, 4, 5 and 6) will win a subscription to Mini eCadets for this academic year (worth £250). The winner will be announced in the Go Bubble Pupil Voice Week Group by 1300 30 Sept.

### **Critical thinking**

Questions to consider when planning their poster slogan:

What are the 3 most important things you have learnt (for online safety)?

If you could do one thing to make the internet a safer and more fun place for children, what would it be?

### **Materials/Extra learning opportunity**
