



ACTIVITY: SAY IT ANOTHER WAY

This activity is all about children and young people using their voices in different ways to show that it is not only words that have an impact but also the way those words are spoken.

It is suggested to use the nursery rhyme Old MacDonald had a farm to complete this activity, however, if working with older children this activity works well with any example text. This could be from the current topic or scheme of work.

This activity can either be completed as a class, with pupils volunteering to take part. You can split pupils into small groups or pairs, with an activity sheet per group. for pupils to work through independently.
