

Objective: The objective for this task is help pupils think about the ways they can make their voice count for themselves, their friends, and the community they live in.

Instructions: As a group, ask pupils to think of as many ways they can make their voices count. Write them on a board as they come up with them. Try to come up with a varied list, discuss each one briefly.

Examples include: To give myself confidence To stand up for my friends To treat my friends and family with kindness To create change in my community

Ask pupils to pick an example from the board. Using their chosen example ask them to create a poster that encourages others to do the same.

Ask your pupils to think about:

The colours, shapes, textures, the situation the example might occur in, who it affects, and how it would make everyone feel.

Once the poster has been created, ask pupils to discuss their posters and why they created their designs.
